What is the Winter Field Archery League.

*The Winter Field League was started in 2003 in South Wales by Gloria and Gerald as a way of introducing new archers to field archery whilst maintaining low key competitions so that established field archers could practice during the winter months.*

*(It gave many archers a reason to go and shoot on a grey winter's day, meet up with friends and blow away the winter cob-webs).*

*Along with this it gave potential venues the opportunity of hosting an event in order to see what is involved.*

*It proved to be extremely popular and has been adopted by the Field committee. It is now run nationally on a more formal basis with venues in many areas of the UK including Northern Ireland. The scores from each meeting are submitted to the WFAL co-ordinator who posts a running results list on the website. At the end of the winter season a final results list is produced, based on an archers 4 best results. There are now medals for the various disciplines which are awarded at the end of the season. Last winter over 250 archers submitted scores the results can be found on the gnasfield website.*

## Directions to Chippenham Archers

After turning off the A350 onto the A420, turn left at the Allington Farm Shop **A**

Follow the road until you come to a Junction **B** (just past the entrance to Sheldon Manor), at this 'Give Way' junction; turn left towards the Chippenham Rugby Club.

As you drive down the lane towards the Rugby Club look to the right, you will first see an entrance to a private house go about on about another 150 yards and you will see, a set of double gates leading to a Farm machinery storage area **C** (If you see the entrance to the Rugby Club on your left then you have gone about 50yds to far!).

Go through the Gates (which should be unlocked if you are expected) and you will see a track straight in front of you, go down the track, past two fields on your right, and you will arrive at our Target Range.



Nearest Post Code for Sat Nav. is SN14 0YZ - but if you arrive there then you have gone about 50yds to far see 'C' above
