

DIRECTIONS TO VENUE (maps attached)

From **Chepstow**, follow A48 (to Gloucester), turn left signposted 'Tutshill', ¾ mile turn right at roundabout, signposted 'Coleford'. Follow B4228 for approximately 12 miles, through crossroads by Coleford Police Station and 300 yards. Turn left into Victoria Road. Follow Archery Signs to field.

From **Monmouth**, follow A4136 until Pikehouse Crossroads (just before garage). Turn right at crossroads, ½ mile until T junction. Turn left then immediately right into Victoria Road. Follow Archery Signs to field.

From **Gloucester**, follow A40 to Huntley. Turn left at traffic lights by Murco Garage onto A4136. Follow signs to Coleford, and at the Pikehouse Crossroads (just after garage on the right) turn left, ½ mile until T junction. Turn left then immediately right into Victoria Road. Follow Archery Signs to field.

Sat Nav Users – GL16 8DS will take you to Victoria Road then follow Archery Signs



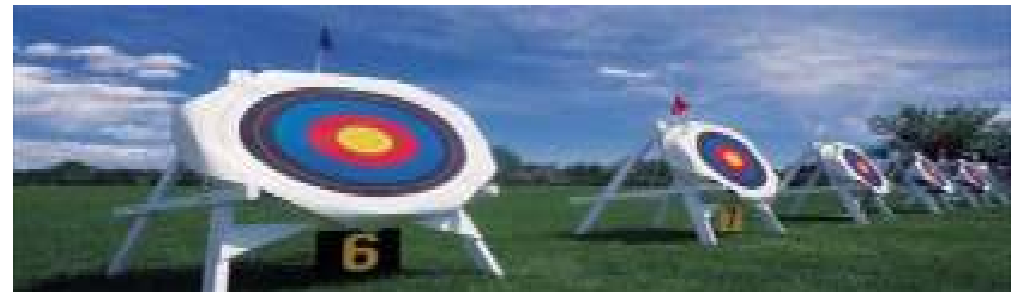
