WINTER POSTAL LEAGUE 2018/2019

GNAS RULES OF SHOOTING APPLY. ENTRY FEE: A Club registration fee of £10 must be enclosed with the first set of scores. Cheques payable to GWAS Please. The matches may be shot Indoors or Outdoors

- 1 Round shot for *10 years and over* to be 3 dozen arrows at 20 yards, on a 60 cm, 10 zone target face. You may use the first 3 dozen from a Portsmouth round.
For archers *9 years and under* the distance to be 10 yards on a 60cm, 10 zone face.
Compound archers to use the inner 10 ring on both distances.
- 2 Individuals may shoot for themselves, a club may enter archers from 1 only to all the juniors in the club.
- 3 Individuals will be grouped into divisions of approximately 8 - 10 archers initially.
- 4 New Archers may join in after the competition has started
- 5 Individuals and teams will be *grouped by ages as at 1st October*, and remain in that group throughout all the matches - Under 18, Under 16, Under 14, Under 12 and Under 10.
- 6 Individuals will be grouped in Styles of Recurve & Barebow, Compound, Longbow, Girls and Boys. Where numbers permit.
- 7 Individuals may shoot at any time during the month, they do not need to shoot at the same time or the same day, one score only to count.
- 8 A Team will consist of 4 archers of any style, but may include *only one compound* archer. A club may enter as many teams as they wish, but no archer may shoot for more than 1 team in any 1 month.
- 9 Teams will be grouped into divisions of approximately 6.
- 10 Team scores can be made up from the above scores as in paragraph 6. A team may contain a mixture of ages and sexes, but must be entered in the groups as in paragraph 4, the eldest member dictates the group.
- 11 The first months' scores will set the divisions.
- 12 Individuals and teams will earn points by the position in their group.
- 13 The tournament will be held over 5 matches. 1- October, 2-November, 3- December & January, 4-February and 5- March. Dec. and Jan have been combined, due to difficulties shooting over the holiday time.
- 14 All results **MUST** be with the organisers by the **5th day of the next month**, if no arrival a "0" score will be entered. **To prevent delays in composing the results sheet, please let us know if you do not shoot.**
- 15 All score sheets should be held by the club co-ordinator for 6 weeks after the tournament has finished, so that if any dispute arises it can be sorted. Failure to do so will mean loss of dispute. Tournament Organisers decision will be final.
- 16 All division winners will receive a certificate - 1st Yellow, 2nd Red, 3rd Blue, with name, style and club
The top team in each age group will receive a GWAS Trophy.
