<b>ROUNDS</b>	Open York/Hereford rounds for Championship, National round in afternoon, non championship
<b>SHOOTING</b>	There will be four archers per boss shooting in two details Timed 6 arrows per end in 4 mins for all rounds
<b>TIMINGS</b>	Equipment inspection from 09:30. Assembly at 10:00 which will be followed by sighters at 10:15. Shooting will follow on from sighters. National round to start at same time as Afternoon Hereford. Approx. 14:00
<b>ENTRY FEE</b>	York/Hereford Round - £13.50 National Round - £11.50 BACS payment via details on entry form Cheques payable to "Somerset County Archery Association"
<b>CLOSING DATE</b>	Saturday 1st June 2019. As space is limited, early entry is advisable.
<b>LATE ENTRY FEE</b>	There will be a late entry fee of £3.00 per person
<b>JUNIORS</b>	Juniors may enter and will be eligible for awards but must shoot the appropriate senior round.
<b>AWARDS</b>	SCAA County and Open Awards for Ladies/Gents shooting Recurve, Compound, Longbow and Barebow according to entry
<b>RULES OF SHOOTING</b>	AGB rules of shooting will apply
<b>DRESS REGULATIONS</b>	AGB Rule 307 will apply
<b>DRUG TESTING</b>	All archers will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers on the entry form.
