



## The 2020 Dunster Covid Challenge Rules



The rounds are as follows;

Western – 4 dozen at 60 yards and 4 dozen at 50 yards on a 122cm face

The “Fun” round – 4 dozen at 50 yards on a 122cm face with a lucky dip scoring system to be advised.

You can shoot one or both rounds as many times as you like but please only submit one score for each round. (See comment below re shooting more than one bow style.)

All recognised target bow styles can partake, if you do not shoot one of these you will be popped in the most appropriate category, i.e. Horsebow would be categorised as Barebow.

If you shoot more than one bow style, you can enter scores for each one i.e. you can submit one score for one or both rounds for each bow style that you choose to shoot.

Results will be split by bow style, ladies and gents and depending on numbers, Regional and Visitors

I will produce a set of results for the individual rounds and also the combined rounds.

If you can only shoot the Western and would like to take part in the “Fun” round, I will accept your 4 dozen at 50 yards for this second round.

Rounds to be shot at any time between Saturday 12th June and Sunday 21st June.

Where possible the round should be shot at a registered club ground. Only archers who can shoot safely and do so in socially distanced settings and accordance with local health guidelines are permitted to participate.

You can shoot it over any number of sessions if you cannot fit the full eight dozen in during one booking.

JiC is Pam Tonkin who will be judging line cutters (and the judge’s decision is final)

Score sheets, along with photos of any line cutters, must be emailed or WhatsApp’d to me by midnight on 21st June.

Please score line cutters with the lower value and mark with an asterisk.

If you have more than one line cutter in a round, please number the photos accordingly.

Score sheets can be hard copy or phone apps, just send me a picture/screen shot.

There will be no awards, you will just have bragging rights for winning this unique Dunster Event, something that can never be taken away from you!
